

ORDINANCE # 02

HOURS OF SELLING INTOXICATING LIQUOR

The Village Board of Cochrane do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Any keeper of any saloon, shop or place of any nature or character whatsoever for the sale of strong, spirituous, malt ardent or intoxicating liquor, within the limits of the Village of Cochrane who shall sell, give away or barter any intoxicating liquors, of who shall keep his saloon or bar room open, or shall permit any person or persons to congregate, linger or loiter in or about any saloon, bar room or other room on such premises in which intoxicating liquor is sold or dispenses or who shall either directly or indirectly permit any intoxicating liquors to be dispensed or served upon the premises so occupied by him, at any time between the hour of 11:00 o'clock p.m. and the hour of 5:00 o'clock am of the succeeding day, shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars, besides costs of suit, or by imprisonment in the county jail of Buffalo County not to exceed sixty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
