

ORDINANCE #09

**MAIN STREET DECLARED ARTERIAL HIGHWAY
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS**

To declare Main Street an arterial highway and to regulate the traffic therein. The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane, County of Buffalo, State of Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1

Main Street in this Village is hereby designated and declared to be an arterial highway for through traffic, and all vehicles are hereby required to come to a full and complete stop before entering or crossing the same.

Section 2

It shall be unlawful for the driver or operator of any vehicle, however propelled, to enter or cross Main Street without first bringing his vehicle to a full and complete stop before crossing the sidewalks in such street.

Section 3

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not more than fifteen (\$15.00) dollars, and in default thereof, by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

Section 4

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
