

ORDINANCE #13

CURFEW FOR THE VILLAGE OF COCHRANE

The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane do ordain as follows:

All children of the age of 15 years and under shall not be permitted on the streets of the Village of Cochrane between the hours of 9 o'clock P.M. and 6 o'clock A.M. unless accompanied by their parents, guardian or other adults of the age of twenty-one years or over, or unless returning home from a public school, church or civic gathering. It shall be the duty of the Marshall of the Village of Cochrane to give warning each night at the hour of 9 o'clock P.M. by sounding one of the Village fire bells, until the further order of the Village Board, but his failure to do so shall not permit children to appear on the streets between the hours of 9 o'clock P.M. and 6 o'clock A.M. except as provided above. It shall be the duty of the Village Marshall to enforce this ordinance at all times.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of the date of its legal publication in the Cochrane Recorder; namely, October 12, 1939.
