

ORDINANCE #19

RAISING OF POULTRY IN VILLAGE

The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane, Buffalo county, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

An ordinance to govern and regulate the keeping and raising of poultry within the Village of Cochrane.

Section 1. No person shall keep, raise or maintain poultry at any time within the Village limits of the Village of Cochrane, unless confined in such a manner that such poultry shall at no time come within fifty (50) feet of any building maintained and occupied as a residence.

Section 2. Any person violating section 1 of this Ordinance shall forfeit to the Village of Cochrane a sum not exceeding Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00). Each day during which the violation of Section No. 1 of this Ordinance continues, shall be considered a separate offense.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
