

ORDINANCE #20

**USE OF SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM**

Initial Resolution for the construction of a sewer system and a sewer disposal plant and for extension and improvement of the water works plant.

Be it resolved by the Village Board of the Village of Cochrane, Wisconsin, as follows:

1. The health, welfare and safety of the inhabitants of the Village require the extension and improvement of the present System of Water Works for said Village to furnish water and fire protection for the Village and for the inhabitants thereof.
2. The health, welfare and safety of the inhabitants of the Village require the construction of a Plant and equipment for the disposal of sewage originating in said Village.
3. It is hereby determined to construct such Plants and System of Water Works and Sewage Disposal constituting public utilities as authorized by Section 66.066 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
4. The plans heretofore prepared by Davy Engineering Company of LaCrosse, Wisconsin, consulting engineers and approved by the State Board of Health, be and the same are hereby approved and adopted as the official plans for said Water Works Plant and Sewage Disposal Plant and System and the same shall be constructed according to such plans, copies of which are on file in the Office of the Village Clerk.
5. The cost of constructing said Sewage Disposal Plant and System and said Water Works Plant, shall be provided by the issuance of direct obligation municipal bonds and by the issuance of revenue aforesaid Plants and Systems.
6. The Village Board is authorized to use the proceeds of said direct obligation municipal bonds and the proceeds of said revenue bonds together with any other funds available for the purpose to construct said Sewage Disposal Plant and System and to extend and improve said Water Works Plant and for such purpose to employ engineers and make contracts for the purchase of all necessary materials, supplies and equipment.

## **USE OF SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM**

The Village Board, of the Village of Cochrane, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, do ordain, as follows: An Ordinance to control and limit the use of the Sanitary Sewer System, in the Village of Cochrane.

It shall be unlawful to permit the entry of industrial wastes into the Village Sanitary Sewer, excepting therefrom, those wastes admission of which is permitted by the Wisconsin State Board of Health and it shall be unlawful to operate the Imhoff Tank Disposal Plant, in the Village of Cochrane, in any manner other than in accordance with the instructions of the Wisconsin Sate Board of Health.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.

### **Amendment to Initial Resolution for the construction of a sewer system and a sewer disposal plant and for extension and improvement of the water works plant.**

Whereas, on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1954, the Village Board, of the Village of Cochrane, Wisconsin, adopted an "Initial Resolution for the Construction of a Sewer System and a Sewage Disposal Plant and for Extension and Improvement of the Waterworks Plant" and whereas, said resolution provided for the manner of payment of the cost of construction of said Sewer System and Sewage Disposal Plant and for extension and improvement of the Waterworks Plant and whereas, the cost of such construction has now been definitely determined:

Now, Therefore, be it resolved by the Village Board of the Village of Cochrane, Wisconsin, as follows:

1. That Paragraph 3, of the "Initial Resolution for the Construction of a Sewer System and a Sewage Disposal Plant and for Extension and Improvement of the Waterworks Plant", adopted May 11, 1954, be and it is hereby amended to read, as follows:

3. *It is hereby determined to construct such Plants and Systems of Waterworks and Sewage Disposal, constituting public utilities as authorized by Section 66.066 of the Wisconsin Statutes.*
2. That Paragraph 5, of the “Initial Resolution for the Construction of a Sewer System and a Sewage Disposal Plant and for Extension and Improvement of the Waterworks Plant”, adopted May 11, 1954 be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:
  5. *The cost of constructing said Sewage Disposal Plant and System, shall be provided by the issuance of \$55,000 Sewage System Mortgage Revenue Bonds, payable solely from the earnings of said Plant and System, the balance of the cost of constructing said Sewage Disposal Plant and System, shall be paid in part by linear foot assessments against all property in the village of Cochrane, fronting or abutting on each side of the said Sewage System for its entire length and in part by the Village at large, through payments out of the general fund of said Village by borrowing such additional funds as may be necessary to complete said construction, such borrowing to be a direct obligation of the Village at large.*

*The cost of constructing the extension and improvement of the Waterworks Plant, shall be provided by the issuance of \$35,000 Waterworks System Mortgage Revenue Bonds, payable solely from the earnings of the said Waterworks System and Plant, shall be paid by the Village at large, by payments out of the general fund of said Village, by borrowing such additional funds as may be necessary to complete said construction, such borrowing to be a direct obligation of the Village at large.*
