

ORDINANCE #27

ON-OFF SALE OF CLASS B LIQUOR LICENSE

An ordinance to authorize, permit, and regulate the on and off-sale of intoxicating liquors by class "B" retail license holders.

The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane do hereby ordain as follows:

Under the provisions of Section 176.05 (2b) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village Board of the Village of Cochrane does hereby elect to permit the holder of a Class "B" retail liquor license, to sell, deal, and traffic in intoxicating liquors, to be consumed by the glass only on the premises so licensed, and in the original package or container, in quantities of not more than one quart at any one time and to be consumed off the premises so licensed, except that wine may be sold in the original package or otherwise in any quantity to be consumed off the premises.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
