

ORDINANCE #36

VILLAGE PLANNING COMMISSION

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF COCHRANE, BUFFALO COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

FIRST, There shall be established in the Village of Cochrane, a "Village Plan Commission" to consist of the President, who shall be its presiding officer, 2 trustees, and four citizen members.

SECOND, The trustee member of the Commission shall be elected by a two-thirds vote of the Board and during each April.

THIRD, Three citizen members shall be appointed by the President to hold office for a period ending one, two and three years, respectively, from the succeeding first day of May, and thereafter annually during April, one such member shall be appointed for a term of three years. The fourth citizen member shall be first appointed to hold office for a period ending one year from the succeeding first day of May and thereafter annually during the month of April. Whenever a Park Board is created in the Village or a Village Engineer appointed, the term of the President of such Board, or the engineer, shall become a member of the Commission in place of the fourth citizen member.

FOURTH, The Village Plan Commission shall have power of authority to employ experts and a staff, and to pay for their services, and such other expenses, as may be necessary and proper, not exceeding in all the appropriation which may be made for such Commission by the Village Board or placed at its disposal through gift, and subject to any ordinance or resolution enacted by the Village Board.

FIFTH, The duties and powers of such Village Plan Commission shall be as set forth in Section 62.23 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
