

ORDINANCE #38

KEEPING OF BEES IN COCHRANE

An ordinance to govern and regulate the keeping of bees and beehives, within the Village limits of the Village of Cochrane.

The City Council of the Village of Cochrane do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall keep or permit the keeping of bees for commercial purposes or the production of honey therefrom, within the Village limits of the Village of Cochrane.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance, in the discretion of the Board, shall not apply to any prior existing and established uses for as long as such usage shall be continuously operated on the premises or buildings actually used for such purposes prior to the passage of this Ordinance, but shall prohibit any expansion of such prior existing usages either as to area in use or as to extension of buildings presently in use.

SECTION 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall forfeit to the Village of Cochrane, a sum not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars and each day during which the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance continues shall be considered a separate offense.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication.
