

ORDINANCE #39

ANNEXATION OF LAND-TOWN OF BELVIDERE

An Ordinance to annex to the Village of Cochrane, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, certain lands within the Town of Belvidere, Buffalo County, Wisconsin.

The Village Council of the Village of Cochrane do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby annexed to the Village of Cochrane, Buffalo County, Wisconsin the following lands now located in the Town of Belvidere, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, to wit:

That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eight (8), Township Twenty (20), North Range 12 West of the 4th P.M., more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast Corner of the aforesaid Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, thence due South 148 feet, thence due West 60 feet, for a point of beginning; said point of beginning coinciding with a point sixteen feet due South of the Southeast corner of Lot One (1) of Block One (1) of Kochenderfer's Addition to the Village of Cochrane; thence due West 127 feet, thence due South 125 feet, thence due East 217 feet, thence due North 125 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. That said lands are less than one square mile in area and are contiguous to the said Village of Cochrane, and that the owners or of this date are George H. Hansen and Dorn A Haeuser.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be effective upon approval of said annexation by the State Planning Director.
