

ORDINANCE #48-A

USE AND OPERATIONS OF SNOWMOBILES

The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

1. That portion of Burlington Street running from 5th Street northwesterly approximately 660 feet to the north line of Block 3 of the Original Plat of the Village of Cochrane is hereby designated as a snowmobile route.
2. Any person may lawfully, and in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 350 of the Wisconsin Statutes, operate a snowmobile upon the above designated snowmobile route within the hours as hereinafter set forth, provided that the snowmobile not be operated at a speed in excess of 15 miles per hour and provided further that any person so operating a snowmobile shall yield the right of way to all vehicular traffic.
3. Snowmobiles shall not be operated on any other public street located within the Village of Cochrane.
4. A snowmobile may be operated upon the above designated snowmobile route only between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 10:30 P.M., except on Friday and Saturday when a snowmobile may be operated between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 12 Midnight.
5. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance may be required to forfeit a sum not in excess of \$100.00, plus the costs of prosecuting any action to enforce this Ordinance.
6. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication.
