

ORDINANCE # 48

SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE

The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

1. Any person may lawfully operate a snowmobile upon the Village of Cochrane street known as Burlington Street on that section of said street between Cedar Street and Seventh (7th) Street and may operate upon that section of Seventh (7th) Street between Burlington Street and Main Street. Said street sections are hereby designated as a snowmobile route.

2. Any person so operating a snowmobile on the above authorized section of Burlington or Seventh (7th) Streets shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicle traffic.

3. Any person operating a snowmobile on a designated snowmobile route may operate on any Village Street only to proceed directly between their place of residence and the snowmobile route and the most direct route must be used.

4. Any person violating any of the provisions of Sections 2 or 3 of this ordinance may be required to forfeit the sum of \$100.00, plus the costs of prosecuting said action.

5. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication.
