

ORDINANCE # 51

**SCHOOL BUS OPERATORS ALLOWED
TO USE FLASHING RED LIGHTS**

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF
COCHRANE, WISCONSIN:

1. That in accordance with Section 349.21, Wisconsin Statutes, school bus operators in a residence or business district within the Village limits may use the flashing red lights for loading or unloading passengers, when pupils or other authorized passengers are to be loaded or unloaded at a location at which there are no traffic signals and such persons must cross the street or highway before being loaded or after being unloaded. Vehicular traffic shall obey such flashing red lights pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes and any pertinent ordinances of the Village of Cochrane regarding vehicular traffic.
2. This ordinance shall take effect after its passage by the Village Board of the Village of Cochrane as provided by law.
