

ORDINANCE NO. 52-AMENDMENT

PROTECTING THE PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM

The Village Board for the Village of Cochrane, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

The following amendment shall be made to Ordinance No. 52, which is entitled
“TO PROVIDE A PROGRAM FOR PROTECTING THE PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM
FROM CONTAMINATION DUE TO BACKFLOW OF CONTAMINANTS THROUGH
THE WATER SERVICE CONNECTION INTO THE PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM.”

SECTION 8a. In the event that the Village Board determines that a cross connection exists, the Board, through the Village Clerk, shall notify in writing the person, firm or corporation establishing or maintaining the same to disconnect said cross connection within 5 days from the date of the notice. Said person, firm or corporation shall satisfy the Village Board that disconnection has occurred within said 5 day period. If, upon the expiration of said 5 day period, the disconnection has not been effected, a violation of this ordinance will be deemed to occur. The penalty for violation of any provision of the Ordinance shall be \$10 per day for each day of violation. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

The remaining provisions of Ordinance No. 52 shall remain in full force and effect.

These amendments shall be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
