

ORDINANCE # 53-A

PRIVATE WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of the Village of Cochrane, State of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. "Private water supply" means one or more sources of ground water, including facilities for storage and conveyance thereof, such as wells, springs, pumps, pressure tanks and reservoirs, on one property, other than those serving a public water system.

SECTION 2. All private water supply systems in the Village of Cochrane, which are used for human consumption shall be metered. Water meters shall be of a type approved by the Village Board or it's designate and shall be installed at the owner's expense at a location approved by the Village Board or its designate.

SECTION 3. From and after the date of October 1, 1984, no private water supply systems shall be constructed unless the same shall meet the requirements of Chapter NR 112, Wisconsin Administrative Code.

SECTION 4. No provision in this Ordinance is intended to alter or conflict with the provisions of Ordinance No. 52 of the Village of Cochrane, relating to the control of cross connections.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

SECTION 6. Any person violating any provisions of this section shall upon conviction be punished by a forfeiture of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$200.00 together with the cost of prosecution. Each 24 hour period during which a violation exists shall be deemed and constitute a separate offense. Penalties shall go into effect January 1, 1985.
